Abstract :

Philippe Brousseau: Bipodal support and orality in question

What characterizes the human being are two functions that are developed by the brain:

- The bipodal support
- The orality

Any disorder of the statics and dynamics at one level will have repercussions at other levels. The goal of this workshop is to reflect on the constraints that can disrupt the proper functioning of our treatments and to understand the purpose of recurrence. As practitioners, we will try to think in a multidisciplinary way. How can we place the anterior guide in an equilibrium relationship with the cervico-occipital hinge in order to release the constraints due to balancing and movement?

Through anatomical-physiology, some fundamentals from the osteopathic approach (neurosensorial pivots) will be discussed. Some aspects of palpatory diagnosis and balancing will be added to the elements of analysis and diagnosis of orofacial functions. A more systemic and postural approach of the body will be associated with the figures, images, randomized studies and clinical studies that we use for our patients. The dento-maxillary morphogenesis is partly dependent on the cranial ensemble but also on the cervical rachis and therefore on the entire skeleton (Dr Creuzet Sophie).
