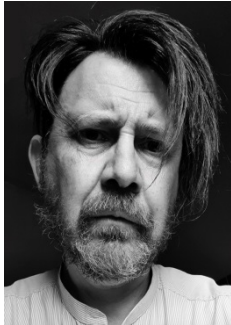

Abstract :

The authors note that Jean Delaire's cephalometric analysis neglects, surprisingly for a tool created by a practitioner coming from the dental world, a fundamental element in the determination of the theoretical ideal facial architecture of a patient.

The consideration of this element and an ontogenic as well as a phylogenic reconsideration of this tool allow us to define a new concept which is that of Hyper Delaire or Hyper Delairian architecture and to study its corollaries.

If only theory (in the etymological sense of seeing the divine) can decide what is observable (Einstein), the question arises as to whether orthognathicists are in fact pleasing themselves with immediate evidence as a therapeutic goal rather than appreciating the deeper implications of the concepts they wield and the difficulties these concepts impose in reaching the truth.
