



Detection of dental disorders in children and very early orthopedics

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Abstract :

Following the example of the "1000 first days" campaign aimed at parents giving the keys to baby's health and development, there should be a "2000 first days" campaign for pediatricians, dental surgeons, physiotherapists, and early childhood professionals in general, in order to make these professionals aware of the key factors in the dento-facial development of children under 6 years of age

Indeed, a certain number of dysfunctions (lips, tongue, suction, ventilation) and misalignments (reversed anterior or lateral bite, infraclusia), having an impact on growth, can easily be detected by non-specialists. Their very early treatment, especially by a specialist in dentofacial orthopedics, is then often simple (we will see some examples) and allows the little patient to get back on track for a harmonious facial growth.
